



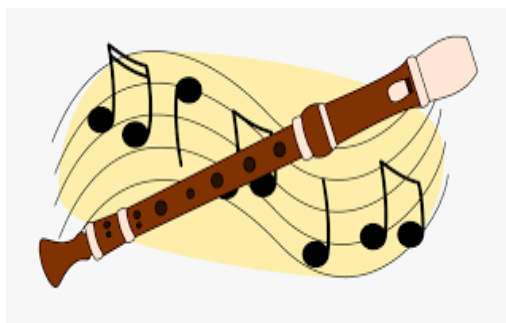
Recorder Concert at St Margaret's Church, Arcadia

On Saturday 10th October 2020, the Magnetic Island U3A Recorder Group, joined by members of the North Queensland Recorder Society will present a small concert of light music.

This is a free concert, open to all. It will begin at 4pm and will take place under the covered area immediately outside the church.

The combined group is expected to number some 14 musicians and they play different types of recorders: soprano, alto, tenor and bass. Together they make a rich sound.

Seven short pieces will be presented, ranging from two South American folk dances through a couple of ever-popular airs from Handel's Water Music, the Scottish folk tune "Wild Mountain Thyme", a song made famous by Judy Garland: "Over the Rainbow" and to finish off, Purcell's well-loved Trumpet Tune.
