## Performance of Noye's Fludde with Australian Festival of Chamber Music

### Introduction

The North Queensland Recorder Society has accepted an invitation from the Australian Festival of Chamber Music to participate in a performance of Benjamin Britten's Noye's Fludde - Noah's Flood - in the AFCM Family Concert at 3:00pm on Saturday 3 August 2013.

Britten scored Noye's Fludde to include both amateur singers and recorder players, as well as a part for professional recorder player. Ruth Wilkinson is playing the professional part while NQRS is providing the players for the amateur recorder orchestra or 'ripieno'.

### Schedule

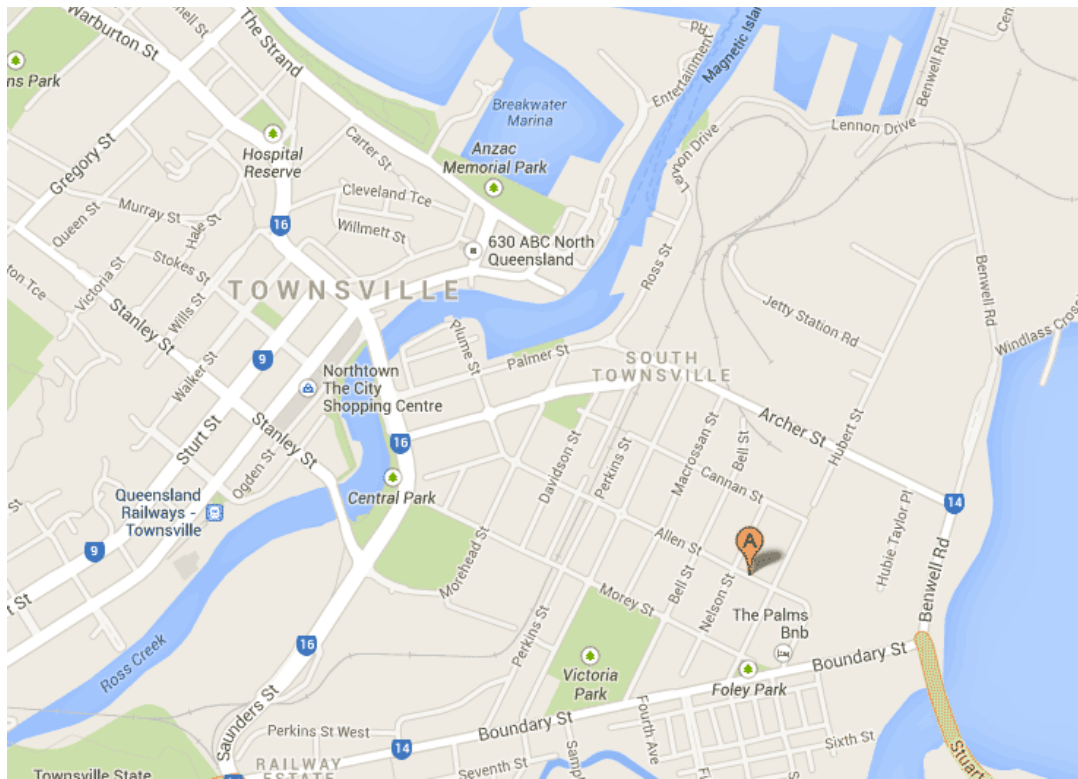
There are two series of rehearsals: the first with just the recorder team from the Society; the second with various combinations of choirs and orchestra. The recorder rehearsals are scheduled for Saturday mornings between 10am and 12 midday and will take place at Valerie's apartment: 9/22 Mitchell Street, North Ward.
