Baby Steps

Beginning to play soprano (descant), alto (treble) or tenor recorder? This short course is for adults with little or no recorder playing experience and will cover basic recorder technique and music reading. All music will be supplied.

4 sessions x 1 hr, Mondays 5 to 26 November, 5.30 to 6.30 pm. Fee \$40 for the four sessions.

Developing Ensemble Skills

For Intermediate players: how to lead a group, conduct, choose music and troubleshoot ensemble problems.

Three sessions x 1.5 hr, Wednesday 7, 14 and 21 November, 7.00 to 8.30 pm. Fee \$35 for the three sessions.

Learning the “Other” Fingering

Introducing people who read music but only play one fingering (soprano / tenor or alto) to the other of them or to bass. Participants will need a copy of Malcolm's Recorder Notebook 2, and other music will be supplied.

Three sessions x 1 hr, Wednesdays from November 28 to December 12, 5.30 to 6.30pm OR 7.30 – 8.30 pm, TBA (tell us which time slot you prefer and we will go with the majority). Course cost \$30 for tuition plus \$10 for the tutor book if needed.

- Class will be cancelled if there are fewer than 4 pre-bookings
- Class size will be limited to 8
