

Skill-building Workshops for NQRS, August – September 2019

Suitable for people returning to playing recorder after a break and for those who attended Malcolm's workshops earlier this year, this short course will revise, consolidate and extend basic recorder skills. Soprano, alto, tenor and bass players are all welcome.

The course assumes that participants already know the first 8 notes on their recorder (D – D' on soprano or tenor, G – G' on alto or bass) and the basics of reading music. From that point we will develop in all directions - range, fluency, reading, ensemble skills, following a conductor, tuning and intonation, etc - according to interest and abilities.

- Six Monday evening sessions x 1 hr, 5.30 - 6.30 pm.
- The course will begin on August 5 and finish on September 16 but we will take a one-week break (tba) along the way.
- Venue: 24 Wentworth Ave, Mundingburra
- Fee \$60 for the six sessions, plus \$10 for Malcolm's *Recorder Notebook 2* if you don't already have a copy.
- Other music will be supplied.
- Please bring a music stand if you have one, but don't worry if you can't.
- Class size will be limited to 6.
- The class will be not proceed if there are fewer than 4 pre-bookings.
