Skill-building workshop, May – June

This short course will revise, consolidate and extend basic recorder skills. Suitable for people returning to playing recorder after a break and for those who attended Malcolm's workshops earlier this year, this course offers a good preparation for the more intensive and challenging NQRS residential workshop on Magnetic Island in July.

Soprano, alto tenor and bass players are all welcome.
